Question and Answer Summaries:

Question: Is transportation an allowable cost?

Yes, transportation is an allowable cost. In the application, please define what the expense will be and what partnerships will be necessary to provide transportation. If a mini-grant is awarded to your agency, the details will be discussed to ensure the expenses are allowable within the grant.

Question: Can telehealth be used to increase the sustainability of services? If so, what objective would this fall under?

Yes, telehealth can be used. This could fall under either objective one or objective four.

Question: Is this grant open to any medical organization?

Yes, any medical organization can apply for the mini-grant.

Question: If an organization decides to partner with another organization can we use the money from the mini-grant to pay the other organization?

Grant dollars can be used for salary and can be used to pay the partnering organization as part of sustainability.

Question: Can grants be used in multiple counties?

Yes, it can be used where services are being offered.

Question: You stated that mentoring is available to grantees, do we need to indicate that we are interested in receiving a mentor on the application?

If an organization indicates on their application they are interested in receiving a mentor, if that organization is selected, a mentor will be provided.

Question: For those who are current awardees can we reapply?

Yes, you may reapply. If an organization wishes to reapply should not reapplying for what they are currently doing.
